The Annual Christmas Presentation day will again be held at the Nepean Dam via Bargo on the 29th of November and it would be great to see more of our Trials riders show their support on the day.

2003 has been a good one for BWP Expert Michael Byrne. His second place in the NSW Titles and fifth at the Aussie Titles are his best yet capped off with his fifth place Trials Des Nations Team result in B Group at Lavorone, Italy. Michael's membership in the team makes him the third only BWP rider to represent his country in the club's 52-year history. By the way, the other two were Geoffrey Curtis in Speedway and Trevor Hunter in Short Circuit. Michael noted he gained invaluable Trials experience from his trip to Europe, which will help him, progress even further in the sport.

Only three BWP riders contested championship classes over the NSW Titles rounds. As mentioned Michael finished 2nd in Open Solo, younger brother Jason took out 3rd in Junior and Bob McGlinchy 18th in Greybeard (only able to rockhop at the Gundaroo round). Jason's place in the junior titles was a very pleasing result with his rapid improvement certainly making him a rider to watch in the future.

The BWP riders that ventured down to Ballarat in October for the Australian MotoTrials Titles represented the club well. The event was held at Mount Boulton on a great property owned by a local trials rider, with Clerk of Course Rockhopper Bob. Michael Byrne finished a great 5th in Open Solo, Jason Byrne 8th in Junior and Footloose Tindall 33rd in the huge Greybeard class. Special mention to Bob Tindall, who in the freezing conditions on the Saturday afternoon, was the only human in the greater Ballarat region dressed in tee shirt, shorts and sandals. Reminded me of Keith Greentree in the early morning at a Wakefield Park Antarctic Roadrace.

A MotoTrial was held on the 2nd of November at Mt Stromlo as part of the 9th Australian Masters Games. The Trials Club of Canberra hosted the event, which drew riders from all over the country to an area, which has been left completely devastated as far as the eye can see by the bushfires. The feature of the event was the weather, which included hail, rain, hypothermic cold and blistering heat all in one day. Well done to BWP medal winners Bill Guthrie, Gold Medal 45 to 49 age group and Bob Tindall, Bronze Medal in the 55 and over age group. A swab was taken from Bob after the event, once again in the Ballarat gear.

2004 will be a huge year for MotoTrials in our state. Dates are being set for our Menai events with the Gandangara Council already giving consent for the use of the area next year. BWP will apply for 3 dates, which again will include an Open. It looks like more clubs than usual want to run opens next year, which is great for trials but will mean only 4 will be title rounds. Don't forget the 2004 Australian MotoTrials Championships to be held at Pacific Park in mid October. Planning is well underway with our club involved not only physically but also financially and we predict it will be the biggest thing in trials ever.

Finally a big thankyou to all the BWP trials fraternity for their support this year, especially at our Open. I received some great feedback after the event with many saying it was the best Open for some time, but unfortunately Walter Barnett Smith's last trial ever. I hope he had a good ride.
