## AUGUST MOTO TRIALS REPORT

The B.W.P.M.C.C. promoted round 4 of the NSW MOTOTRIALS Championships, which were held at Menai on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2005. It was once again a great success. There was positive feedback received from the riders of all grades and no reported injuries. A big well done goes to all of the officials, especially the newer members, for their efforts during the event. Special thanks must go to Bob Tindall for organising the observers, Steve Byrne and Graham Peace for helping set sections and Lee Tyerman and Keith Greentree for the catering.

It was good again to see lots of spectators including veteran B.W.P. members Norm Aldridge (Multi N.S.W. Trials Champion) and Ken Anslow. Also in attendance was the Sutherland Traffic Sergeant who is now filling out reports on all of our events and indicated there will be a far greater police presence in the Menai area. This is due to recent fatalities and serious injuries amongst the horde of illegal riders and 4 wheel drivers who converge on the area. He commented in a follow up call that the situation was even further out of control than he had initially expected.

The low point of the weekend occurred on the Saturday afternoon when a two groups of 4-wheel drivers decided to trash two Porta-Loo's that had just been delivered. A situation ensued that almost ended in violent confrontation for fellow member Steve Byrne and myself. This is one of the unfortunate downsides of Menai.
