I recently received news of the death after a long illness of Trials rider Harry Valerio who had moved to South Australia some years ago. Harry competed in all types of motorcycle events in Britain before moving to Australia and joining the club. Here he specialised in Trials and when I began riding in 1977 Harry was responsible for all of the club Trial's events. Harry's son Peter was also a very talented trials rider and was BWP Junior and Senior Trials Champion. I attended Harry's funeral service at Peter's property at Bowral on 22-6-2001 and the club sent a floral tribute.

In early June Bob Tindall and myself attended the Crusty Demons World Tour at the Superdome. One of the highlights was the Trials display put on by Kevin and Colin Zarczynski, Martin O'Connor and B.W.P. member Michael Byrne. Michael has been in our club for a few years now and started riding Trials as a Junior. He finished his Junior career with a 3rd place at the Australian Titles in Victoria and has now gone on to be a top line Expert rider. It is great for the club and for Michael that his talents have been recognised and he can now appear with his peers in front of 15,000 people and put on such a wonderful display. Congratulations Michael!

The BWP/ Lower Mountains Open Trial at Menai was a great success and with an entry of 89 riders was the biggest Open Trial for many years. Much credit must go to the many members that gave their time setting the sections, observing, keeping score and cleaning up after the Trial. It made me very proud to be president. Special thanks to Alan Dunn (Wollongong) for

spending most of Saturday cleaning up the car park on his Bobcat, Paul Long for supervising the score keeping and for Bob Tindall for his great input as Chief Observer. In general the Trial was very well received by nearly all competitors and I received a lot of positive feedback on both the sections and the competent observing by our members. Michael Byrne put in a top effort to finish 4th in the ultra competitive Expert class and father Steve put in a gutsy effort to take out the Masters class. This was just reward for both members who both put a huge effort into setting the sections. Once again thanks and we may do it again next year.

The second round of the Club Championship was held at Menai on the 22-7-2001 in a new area west of the carpark . Veteran Menai rider Steve Byrne, along with Michael, used his extensive knowledge of the terrain to set 8 good sections. 42 riders made up the entry with 15 from BWP.
