Don't forget the annual presentation day at Nepean Dam on 30th of November 2002, where trophies and perpetual trophies will be presented.

The Trials Club of Canberra at Gunderoo conducted the final round of the NSW titles in September. The event was of the usual great standard of all TCC events on a great property, with a good range of terrain used to great effect by the section setters. 8 BWP riders made the trip down the Hume with some great results. Michael Byrne took 3rd place in Expert, Garry Smith 2nd in Clubman, and Jason Byrne 3rd in Junior. Jason is showing a rapid improvement onto the mighty GasGas 80, and I'm sure that in a few short years he will be achieving the standards set by his father Steve, and elder brother Michael. Only 2 BWP riders contested the title classes, with Michael Byrne contesting 3rd over all in the Open Solo class, and Bob McGlinchy finishing 8th in Greybeards.

The 2002 Australian Trials Championship was conducted by the Keyneton MCC at Menglers Hill, Barossa Valley, South Australia on the October long weekend. The weather was not the greatest, but the event was conducted at a standard befitting of the National Titles over a venue that boasted the greatest view ever. The event was won by Kiwi ace Warren Laugesen, with Kevin Zarczynski putting in a fantastic ride to be the best Australian. BWP expert Michael Byrne put in his best performance ever to finish 6th in the Open Solo, and Rockhopper Bob finished way back in 24th place in Greybeards, after receiving a more than dubious 5 on lap 1 of the first day. The effect of this must have influenced his final result.

It has certainly been a champagne year for the Clubs Trials Champion Michael Byrne. Michael's 3rd in the NSW Titles, and his brilliant 6th in the Australian Titles ranks him up with the BWP's best ever Trials riders. Norm Aldridge strung together 10 NSW Titles before there was an Australian Championship, and Greybeard ace John Thomas won the 1985 Australian Championship. Michael stated when accepting his award that all the time, effort and money put into his trials career by himself, and his parents is finally paying off. I am sure all club members will join me in congratulating Michael, and wishing him great success in his future endeavours.

The Motorcycle and Scooter Show held recently at the Homebush Showground featured multiple daily trials demonstrations put on by Don Murray, and team Sherco. Don was joined by 1998 Australian Champ Kale Reed, Luke Anderson and Martin O'Connor, with the boys putting on a great display of trials riding and tricks to a large, and very impressed crowd. I was manning the nearby MNSW stand, and with Don, answered many questions from people wanting to become involved in trials. As a footnote to this, Kale indicated he is going to return full time to trials after a long lay-off, and recent injuries.

I was joined at the Saturday night World Speedway Grand Final by ex-president and life member Gordon Marx, who now lives on Queensland's Gold Coast. Since moving to QLD, Gordon has become very involved in the Gold Coast Silkolene Speedway at Labrador, and has asked me to let any BWP members going up that way look him up if they wish to have a great night at the Speedway.
